Dedicating his expertise to academia, Dato Dr. Muhammad Nur Manuty began his illustrious career as a lecturer in the Department of Arabic Studies and Islamic Civilization at UKM. His teaching prowess and scholarly contributions were highly regarded, leading him to assume the roles of Senior Lecturer and Associate Professor in the Department of Usuluddin and Comparative Religion at the prestigious International Islamic University of Malaysia (UIAM) from 1983 to 1999.
